- » select a suite of resources for use in coaching and PL at school;
- » review case studies of high performing schools and identify elements to sustain high-impact instruction;
- » identify opportunities to strengthen the creation and embedding of low-variance curriculum;
- » use a diagnostic tool to audit the state of instructional materials and curriculum in your context;
- >> create a network of experienced alumni across high performing schools;
- » develop and implement a simple targeted action plan to drive success back at school.
