This short program is designed to support teams who are looking to create knowledge-rich, coherent unit plans. The program aims to help teams of teachers to identify the key elements of a knowledge-rich unit, and then plan and create a unit of their own.

During the program, participants will have the opportunity to gain expert feedback on their units. Units developed as part of this program could be drawn from any part of the curriculum.

Developing a Knowledge-Rich Unit



Who is it for?

This program is designed for school-based leadership teams who are keen to develop their understanding of curriculum, its evaluation and implementation. Leadership teams could include middle leaders or principals (depending on school context).

Participants can be from all states and territories and all sectors. Although this course will draw on Ochre resources to demonstrate key concepts, it is relevant for all schools, irrespective of whether they use Ochre materials or not.

How is it structured?

There are three 3-hour virtual workshops (via Zoom) (scheduled during late mornings AEST / early mornings AWST), in which school teams learn together and apply that learning in session.

Alongside these webinars are two opportunities to talk with our curriculum experts to gain feedback and problem-solve the next steps.

It will require a commitment from teams of between 15 - 25 hours of work. All workshops will also be recorded for review.

When does the program run?

Cohort 1 will kick-off in Term 1 2026 to support planning for the 2026 school year.
