Application Process



Who can apply

- >> Teachers with students in Kindy-Year 2.
- » Lead teachers, including Head of Learning Areas/Department, Faculty and instructional leaders with classroom teaching responsibilities.
- » Administrative leaders, including principals, associate principals and deputies.

Two streams are offered in each cohort:

- 1. a Teaching Stream, where teachers complete video selfreflection coaching cycles and other teaching related tasks. We recommend the Teaching Stream for any educator with a teaching load.
- 2. an <u>Administrative Leader Stream</u>, where leaders complete tasks focused on leading high-impact instruction in their schools including online sharing sessions.

How to apply

- » Discuss the opportunity with staff, including the requirement to take video and decide which teachers you would like to nominate.
- » Ensure:
 - ☐ Participant availability for all five professional learning days.
 - ☐ You can nominate a school leader to support your participants through the course, including taking and sharing video of their classroom with Teach Well.
 - □ A senior administrative member can attend Practical Session 1 (at no additional cost).
- » Submit your application at <u>teach-well.au/apply</u>.

Course Cost

Thanks to the generous support of a philanthropist, successful applicants will be awarded a scholarship towards this cost.

- >> Scholarship Price: \$3,250 + GST per successful applicant.
- >> Schools to pay for all additional costs including relief.

Schools applying for four places in the teaching stream can receive a fifth place in the admin stream (for administrators with no teaching load) at no extra cost.

Applications are selective. To increase the likelihood of securing places, schools are encouraged to send a minimum of 2 participants, with a senior school leader attending the first Practical Session (at a minimum).
