Upon completion, participants receive a certificate crediting time for completion of preparation tasks, practice and workshop days (equivalent to 100 hours).

Application Process

Who can apply

- >> Teachers with students in Year 3 10.
- » Lead teachers, including Heads of Learning Area/ Department, Faculty and instructional leaders with classroom teaching responsibilities.
- » Administrative leaders, including Principals, Associate Principals and Deputies.

Schools in the Perth metro area, or otherwise local to our Western Australia–based workshops, are kindly requested to consult our WA Masterclass Series brochure for course options.

Two streams are offered in each cohort:

- Teaching Stream, where teachers complete video self-reflection coaching cycles and other teaching related tasks. We recommend the Teaching Stream for any educator with a teaching load.
- Administrative Leader Stream, where leaders complete tasks focused on leading high-impact instruction in their schools including online sharing lessons.

How to apply

- » Discuss the opportunity with staff, including the requirement to take video and decide which teachers you would like to nominate.
- » Ensure:
 - ☐ Participant availability for all five professional learning days.
 - ☐ You can nominate a school leader to support your participants through the course, including taking and sharing video of their classroom with Teach Well.
 - ☐ A senior administrative member can attend Practical Session 1 (at no additional cost).
- » Submit your application at <u>teach-well.au/apply</u>.

Course Cost

- >> The course price is \$2,500 + GST per successful applicant.
- >> Schools to pay for all additional costs including relief.

Schools applying for four places in the teaching stream can receive a fifth place in the admin stream (for administrators with no teaching load) at no extra cost.
