Application Process

Please note there are a maximum of 75 places for each Masterclass cohort. Applications are selective and will be processed as received. To increase the likelihood of securing places, schools are encouraged to commit to sending a minimum of 2 participants.

Who can apply

- » Teachers with students in K-Year 10.
- » Lead teachers, including Head of Learning Areas/Department, Teachers in Charge and instructional leaders with classroom teaching responsibilities. Administrative leaders, including principals, associate principals and deputies.

How to apply

- » Discuss the opportunity with staff and decide which teachers you would like to nominate.
- » Ensure the availability for your teachers for all five professional learning days.
- » Determine which senior administrative member will attend Practical Session 1 (at no additional cost).
- » Submit your application at teach-well.au/apply.

Course Cost
